



Future Tenses in English

- Future Simple** – actions that have not yet happened
- a voluntary action
 - a promise
 - a plan
 - a prediction

Example: I will cook dinner tonight.
I am going to leave work early.
I will help you move.
Michael Ignatieff will be Prime Minister.

- Future Continuous** – *interrupted action in the future*
- a specific time as an interruption in the future
 - to express parallel actions in the future
 - to describe the atmosphere in the future

Example: I will be watching TV when she arrives tonight.
At 8:00pm, we will be eating dinner.
They will be studying and we will be cooking dinner.
When he arrives at the party, everyone will be celebrating.
