



Parts of Speech

Noun	person, animal, place or thing <u>Christine</u> likes <u>cats</u> at <u>home</u> .
Pronoun	substitute for nouns <u>She</u> feeds <u>her</u> cats everyday.
Verb	action word The cats <u>play</u> and <u>sleep</u> during the day.
Adjective	descriptive words Not all cats are <u>playful</u> and <u>happy</u> .
Adverb	describes verbs The cats purr <u>happily</u> when they are <u>finally</u> fed.
Preposition	describes position Christine allows the cats <u>on</u> her bed and <u>in</u> the kitchen.
Conjunction	joining words Christine likes her cats <u>and</u> she likes her dog.
Articles	the, a, an <u>The</u> cats are used to living with <u>a</u> dog in <u>an</u> apartment.



Examples:

Michael works in a busy store.
noun **verb** **preposition** **article** **adjective**

He cries loudly and he stomps.
pronoun **verb** **adverb** **conjunction**
